Another restored heritage property will open in Oslo, in the former electrical company HQ. It's a 1930s building, all clean lines and red brick, that's undergone a costume change. It will house the Norwegian capital's first rooftop pool, as well as carefully rehabilitated Art Deco baths and sauna. Rooms subvert the expected Scandi-minimalist vibe, swerving instead into serious decadence with plenty of layered textures and local art. A Japanese-Nordic restaurant from award-winning chef Frida Ronge is one of four spots for supper, and two bars will open on the site too. A behemoth of an opening.
