

## The most stylish new hotels to book in 2022

From the new Scandi city break to chilled out Mykonos, Suzannah Ramsdale picks the year's chicest escapes

et's be honest, getting away is as much about the rest and relaxation as it is for gathering fresh content for the 'gram. And the pandemic doesn't seem to have slowed the flow of new hotels. From New York to Norway and Ibiza to Iceland, here is our pick of this year's hotspots.

## Sommerro, Norway

Wake up in Scandi Art Deco heaven at Sommerro. There's much buzz about the opening of this 231-room luxury grand dame in the heart of Oslo's historic Frogner neighbourhood, where the HQ of the city's Thirties electrical company has been renovated in tribute to original architects Andreas Bjercke and Georg Eliassen. A behemoth of a place, there are seven bars and restaurants, a library, 100-seat private cinema, rooftop pool (the city's first) and what the owners are describing as a "sprawling wellness paradise" with a restored Roman bath, complete with its original Per Krohg mosaic.
