Sommerro - Opening September 2022

WHERE: Oslo, Norway

Located in the leafy confines of [Norway's Frogner neighborhood](#), [Sommerro](#) is set to become the city's first art deco hotel and part of Norway's largest preservation project. The hotel pays tribute to Norwegian cultural heritage with original artwork from Norwegian artist Per Krohg and custom upholstery and tile work throughout the 231 rooms and residences within the historic building.
