Sommerro, Oslo, Norway Opening September 2022

For a dose of Art Deco fabulousness, look no further than the latest offering from <u>Nordic Hotels & Resorts</u> – <u>Sommerro</u> in Oslo. The hotel is slap bang in the middle of town, housed in the former HQ of <u>Oslo Lysverker</u>, the city's electrical company on Solli Plass in Frogner.



The transformation of this landmark 1930s building into a 231-room hotel has been masterminded by Norwegian <u>LPO Architects</u> and London- and New York-based studio <u>GrecoDeco</u>. And what a job they've done. Beautiful oak parquet flooring, vibrant frescos and murals, and exquisite detailing in the furnishings all stay true to the spirit of the place, across the rooms, four restaurants and three bars. A 100-seat gilded theatre and an 8,000 sq ft underground wellness haven mean you might never want to leave.

Certainly not when you ascend to the city's first year-round rooftop pool, sauna and terrace, home to Tak Oslo, a Nordic-Japanese restaurant by awardwinning Swedish chef Frida Ronge. It's also a great vantage point to spot the myriad museums, galleries, antiques stores and restaurants in the neighbourhood, as well as the iconic Frogner Park, Oslo's biggest inner city green space.
