Indonesia

Renowned for its surf, the island of Sumba has garnered a reputation as a quieter alternative to Bali. With a rustic, relaxed vibe, the opening of Cap Karoso in September will only add to its awayfrom-it-all allure. Morocco

Close to Marrakech, yet far enough from the bustle of the city in the peaceful countryside, Beldi Country Club is the best of both worlds. In March it will open a new hotel-within-a hotel. Portugal

Wine lovers should check in to Lisbon's newest place to stay, the Palácio Ludovice, which will be opening its doors in one of the capital's most atmospheric quarters, Chiado, later this year. Guest rooms merge traditional Portuguese style with more up to date accents. There will also be a restaurant serving locally sourced ingredients and a Caudalie spa, while the barrel-vaulted cellar bar will be the place to explore Portugal's liquid assets. Greece

Most visitors head to the islands, but the Greek mainland is a canny choice for beach life close to Athens. In April, Brown Beach House Corinthia will be planting its flag in the sands of the Saronic Gulf. less than an hour from the Greek capital. Housed in the former HQ of the capital's original electrical company, September's opening of Sommerro promises to be something of an event. Hungary

The renovation of Budapest's landmark New York Palace Hotel will be complete this year when it joins the Anantara portfolio of hotels.
